SINGER/SONGWRITER LESA HUDSON ROCKS
THE CHRISTIAN COUNTRY MARKET WITH SOLO CD, "NOT ME"

FLORENCE, SC, June 12, 2006—Lesahudson (www.lesahudson.com) has charmed audiences around the country with her charismatic voice, soulful style and contagious smile for nearly 10 years through her trio, N'Accord. Now she debuts her first solo recording, "Not Me" (which includes 11 songs—nine of them written or co-written by Lesa) to the Christian Country radio market. Her hit single "Lukewarm Christian" has been heard on Indieheaven.com's radio charts for over 12 weeks, peaking at #26 and gaining a loyal following among independent recording artists and listeners. The song also charted on the nationally published Christian Radio Weekly Indie Top 40 for 3 months in a row (March - May 2006).

Through her partnership with Indieheaven.com, Lesa's music is already gaining worldwide internet radio attention—even prior to her CD release. Lesa's management group, That's Lesa!, has been set up for official booking, and she has also formed a music publishing company, Keepen Smilen' Music, to copyright her original and co-written songs. A single is planned for release to the Christian Country radio market this summer along with a CD release concert (dates & locations to be announced).

"Lesahudson's style is so upbeat and full of emotion, it really draws listeners in and begs them to come back for more," comments Kevin Smith, Six+1 Studios, producer for "Not Me." "I predict her solo CD is going to rock the Christian market and earn her a loyal fan base."

For Lesahudson, letting go of her own desires and giving God control over this and other areas of her life were the biggest stepping stones to the completion of "Not Me." Lesahudson notes, "When I finally let go of 'me' and gave God complete control of my life, He renewed my spirit with a passion for serving Him like never before. My life has real meaning, real purpose, real direction and a new desire to sing His praises," she admits. "I don't ever want to go back to my old empty meaningless life when God wasn't in full control. Now, it's God—'Not Me.'"

Although the release of "Not Me" marks a pinnacle for Lesahudson, it is not the first of her successes: Her previous two CDs with longstanding trio N'Accord have boosted her popularity in the Christian music community. Lesahudson performed an impressive 45 events during 2005, has performed for Vice President Dick Cheney and sang the National Anthem at the NASCAR Craftsman Truck Race in Darlington, SC, a nationally televised event.

A member of the Christian Country Music Association and Gospel Music Association, Lesahudson was a 2005 Exalting Him Semi Finalist, and was recently nominated for Female Vocalist of the Year, Contemporary Artist of the Year and Country Artist of the Year for the 2006 Indieheaven Momentum Awards. She received a nomination for Best Performance Award for her appearance in the Florence Little Theatre's 2006 production of *Jerry's Girls*. And she is a semi-finalist in the Contemporary Christian Music Network International Talent Search 2006 (winner to be announced the summer of 2006).
